-Meeting was called to order by David at 14:00.

- -Board discussed requirements for GTF sanctioned tournaments. The board added the following at the meeting:
 - 1. Tournament sanctionings must be approved by the executive board (David, Richard, Susan) in order for a director to receive support from the GTF (use of GTF logo, support from referees, etc.).

-Other business:

The board is hoping this becomes an annual event to fellowship, exchange ideas, and have fun. The tentative date for the party is December 1. Master Pius agreed to serve on this committee and will get 3-4 additional people to assist the executive board with this event.
